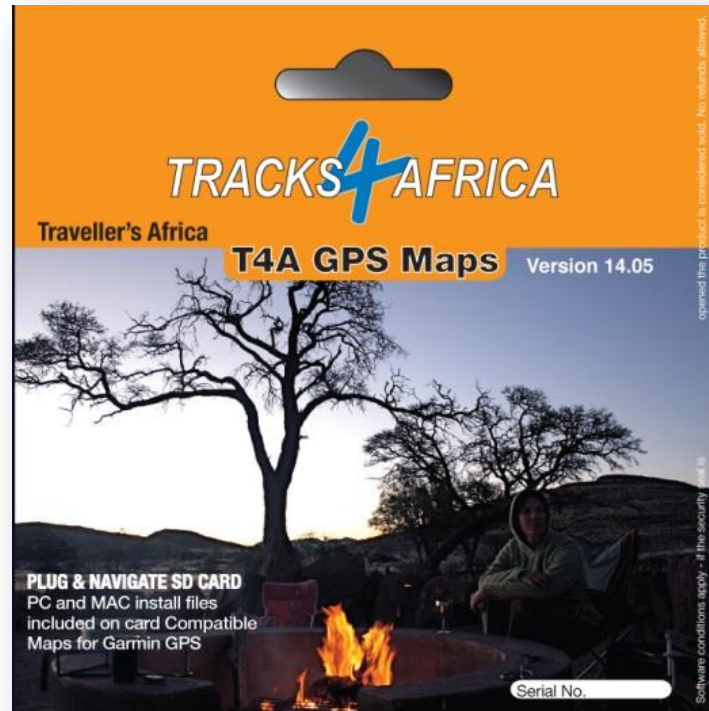


# What is new on the T4A GPS Maps – Traveller's Africa 14.05

T4A GPS Maps 14.05 comes preloaded on a **2Gb micro SD** card with standard adapter, ready for **Plug & Navigate**.

This SD card can be used on most map capable **Garmin** units and has been tested with latest Nuvi models as well. ***This product is not compatible to iGO in car navigation systems, Android or iOS devices. For these platforms we have separate products.***

The SD card also contains **installation files for PC and Mac** users who want to install the maps on their computers for trip planning or for transferring maps to older Garmin units such as the 276c, 76csx, previous generation eTrex, etc.



The map growth is organic in nature. We processed **731 data submissions for version 14.05**. These data submissions not only contribute more roads and POI's to the map, it also improves the quality of existing data by means of corrections. The overall road coverage has increased by **5%** from 13.10.

**Western and Northern Cape** has been updated from 157 individual data submissions and although the map growth for this region is not big, the large amount of data submissions have a huge impact on changes to existing map coverage.

The last **Voetspore expedition** by Johan Badenhorst is now configured on the map. The expedition traversed Africa from east to west via countries such as Kenya, Uganda, DRC and Angola. The most prominent changes that came from this data submission was the border crossing between **Uganda** and **DRC** as well as the route by road and river boat which connects the east and west of the country. The majority of these changes are configured in the **Western Africa** map region.

**Tunisia** and **Libya** has seen a major overhaul. We revisited a lot of un-processed data submissions in this region to increase the map coverage by 31%

In **Malawi** we worked on a project with the Mountain Club of Malawi to build a detailed hiking map of **Mt Mulanje**. This is a truly unique map of this country's highest and most prominent massif.

In **Morocco**, the new Port Tanger is now configured.

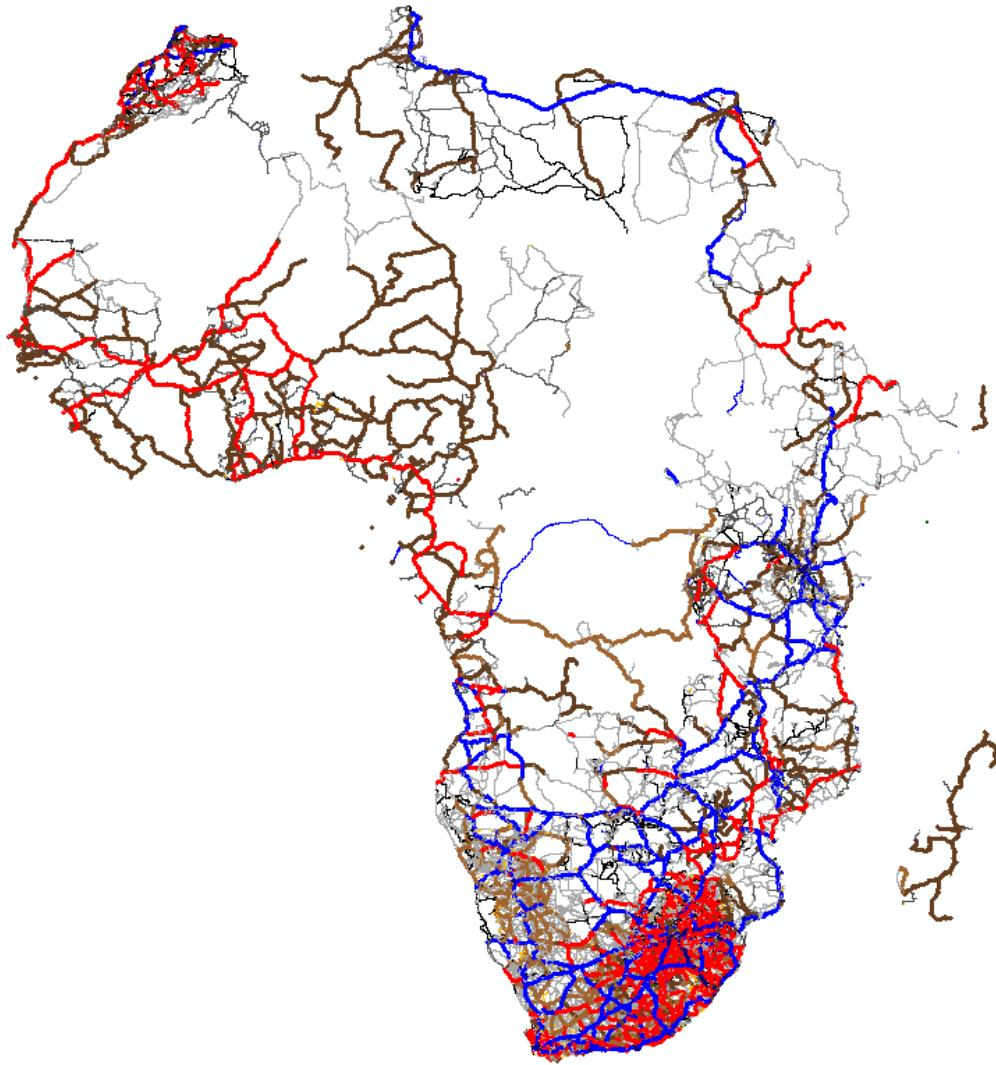
In **Ethiopia** the Borena-Sayint National Park has been added.

**Saadani National Park** on the coast of **Tanzania** has been updated.

In **Namibia** the western part of **Etosha National Park** is now open to tourists. The roads in this area have been made navigable on the latest map.

## Map Coverage

- **809 560km** of roads, detailed tourist coverage and fully navigable (5% increase from 13.10)
- **129 170** points of interest (2% up from 13.10)
- Most complete and detailed **protected areas (national parks, game reserves etc)** in Africa – **1452 parks** in total.
- **9 844 accommodation** listings (3% up from 13.10)
- **3 560 camp sites**, **the most complete camping data base in Africa** (3% up from 13.10)
- **5 454 places to eat or drink** (3% up from 13.10)
